Western Maryland Half Marathon

The Course will begin at the Joseph Hancock Park, just off Main Street in the historic town of Hancock. The out-and-back course allows participants to run west on the Western Maryland Rail Trail approximately 6.5 miles, turnaround and complete the race near the start.

Awards will be given to the first overall female and male finisher and the top three finishers of the half marathon in the following female and male age categories: 19 & under; 20-29; 30-39; 40-49; 50-59; 60-69; 70+
